The International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) will hold an International Symposium on Standards, Applications and Quality Assurance in Medical Radiation Dosimetry from 9 to 12 November 2010, at its Headquarters in Vienna

The symposium will provide a forum where advances in medical radiation dosimetry and applications in medicine during the last decade can be disseminated and scientific knowledge exchanged.

It will include external beam radiotherapy, brachytherapy, diagnostic radiology and nuclear medicine.

The symposium is addressed to a broad spectrum of experts in medical radiation dosimetry, such as medical physicists working in hospitals and/or teaching in universities, radiation physicists working in calibration and dosimetry laboratories and scientists working in research and development in this area.

Participation forms A to the IDOS Symposium can be submitted either through EFOMP or through the National authorities by 31 May 2010 (last date for the enrolment)

We propose that colleagues in your country who are members of your organisation be encouraged to submit their participation to the conference through EFOMP instead of the usual route via your local Competent Authority.
