It is our great pleasure to invite you for the NACP 2008 symposium to be held June 4-5, 2008 in Aarhus, Denmark.

The Nordic Association for Clinical Physics (NACP) is the umbrella organisation for the Nordic medical physics societies. NACP have decided to hold common Nordic symposium, which is replacing both the annual national Danish and Norwegian meetings in 2008. The NACP symposium will be organized as a two day long scientific meeting with dedicated parallel sessions from all three main disciplines in medical physics, i.e., diagnostic imaging, nuclear medicine and radiotherapy. The scientific program will consist of invited talks by outstanding individuals in their field as well as paper presentations based on submitted abstracts. A scientific committee will set with representatives from all Nordic countries and all three medical physics branches. There will also be time allocated for presentations from the recipients of the Varian-NACP-grant and other awards given by the national societies as well as the national general assemblies. The meeting is expected to attract scientists and speakers from both the Nordic countries and internationally. The social program includes a banquet and other possibilities for networking with your colleagues.

Aarhus is the second largest city in Denmark beautifully located at the east coast of Jutland. Although founded by the Vikings in the 8th century, Aarhus is today a modern city, where about every fifth of the 300.000 inhabitants is a student at one of the city's many educational and research institutions, giving the city a young and exciting vibrancy of its very own. Apart from recreational possibilities in the beautiful surroundings the city offers excellent dining and entertainment opportunities including a number of museums and galleries.

The NACP symposium will take place immediately before of the 6<sup>th</sup> Acta Oncologica symposium on image-guided radiotherapy (IGRT). IGRT is a major scientific area within radiotherapy with activities relevant for all three disciplines of medical physics, including various forms of functional as well as anatomical imaging. The IGRT 2008 symposium is expected to attract scientists and speakers from both the Nordic countries and internationally.
